

Wyoming Medicaid to Allow Utilization of Canvas DX Diagnostic Solution

Effective July 1, 2024, Wyoming Medicaid will allow the utilization of Canvas DX, the first and only FDA-authorized diagnostic solution, to diagnose Autism Spectrum Disorder in children 18 months to 6 years old.

The following codes will be utilized throughout the Canvas Dx assessment:

- **HCPCS A9291**: digital cognitive and/or behavioral therapy tool
 - **Billed by Autism Path 2 Care (AP2C)**
- **CPT 96112**: developmental test administration, by a physician or other qualified health professional, with interpretation and report; first hour would be assigned for this service.
 - **CPT 96113**: each additional 30 minutes

Documentation Requirements:

- Rationale for appropriateness of the assessment:
 - Documented M-CHAT score of ≥ 3 – Children < 48 months of age
 - CAST score of 15+ – Children > 48 months of age
 - **This will be attached to the claim when A9291 is billed.**
- Interpretation of results, discussion with caregiver, and delivery of final output report to caregiver and Clinician.
- Canvas Dx output report once finalized by clinician – AP2C for Canvas Dx claim submission.

Providers interested in utilizing the tool in their clinics will work with AP2C to administer the assessment. Cognoa/AP2C will contact clinics in the coming weeks to discuss the process with interested providers.
